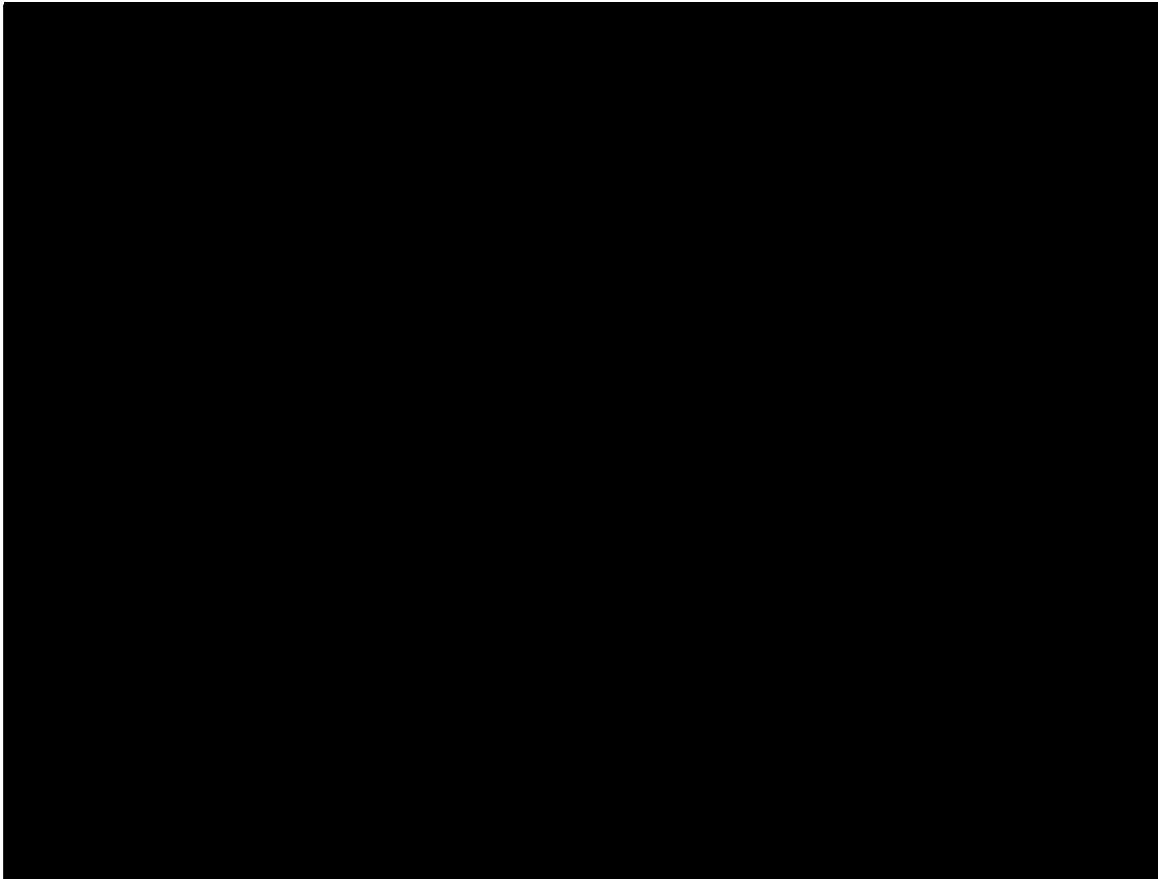

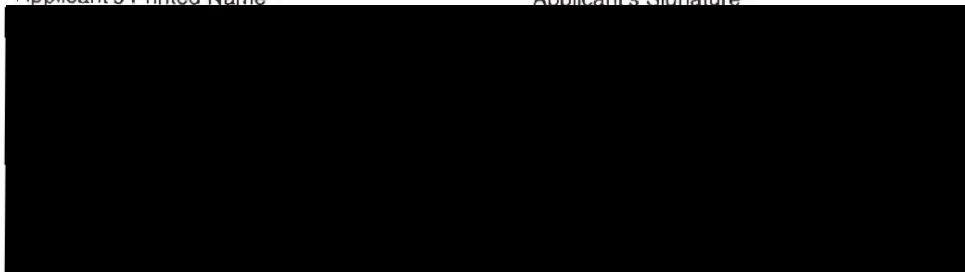
1. Played volleyball including practice and games
