On Monday, March 28th, three new members of our council (Sean Cruz, Evan Swindle, and Danny Guzman) received their third-degree exemplification at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in Plano. The degree team did an excellent job explaining the degrees of charity, unity, and fraternity. They showed due respect for the principles bequeathed to us by Father McGivney. The ceremony lasted about twenty-five minutes and was open to family and friends. In discussing the unity of the Order, the team illustrated the flimsiness of the pieces of string versus the rope bound into an unbreakable unit. This strength came into focus with the Solidarity Fund the Order started to aid the refugees fleeing Ukraine. The Knights of Columbus donated a million and a half dollars and then invited the membership to join in the effort. To date, over nine million dollars have been donated to the fund which is being used to provide shelter, food, medical supplies, clothing, and communications to the refugees. The Order is working with the councils in Poland and the Latin and Greek Catholic Churches in Ukraine.

Sean, Evan, and Danny – indeed all of us – joined into an organization with vast potential when we joined the Knights. It's easy to lose sight of this as we get caught up in meetings and serving coffee and donuts. But, gentlemen, please let us never forget the power of the Holy Spirit working in unity when two million knights come together. Let us shirk neither the responsibility nor the burden that Father McGivney calls us to.
