## A MESSAGE FROM THE GRAND KNIGHT

### Worthy Brothers:

At this juncture of our council's history, after twenty-five years in operation, I would like to propose that we make a sincere effort to open our council to the Hispanic families in our parish. The Order, at all levels, has been encouraging this for a long time. We know that the demographics of our parish places us in prime position for this. The ACTS Program is proof that both the Hispanic and Anglo communities can come together in common interest. The annual St. Paulapalooza Festival demonstrates this as well.

There are three routes we can take: incorporating new Hispanic Knights into our council, forming a Hispanic round table of ten to twelve Knights, or establishing a fully Hispanic council to operate in parallel with ours. There are arguments for and against each of these choices. Rather than making this decision ourselves, we need to establish a dialogue with the Hispanic men in the parish so we can educate them as to our scope and mission and have them decide if and how they would like to serve under the K of C banner. Of course, our pastor will be part of that conversation.

The chance of this being successful depends upon our approaching the Hispanic men who both believe in our mission and who have the leadership skills and the time to attract the right men into the fold.

Let us please pray that we make wise decisions and reach out to the Hispanic men who can make this happen.
