He called on Deputy Grand Knight Gordon Adams to update the council on his efforts to establish a Squires Circle at this parish. The Deputy Grand Knight said he has been talking with the St. Joseph council about that. Squires is set up similar to Scouting, where it has certain levels of achievement. There are three or four Circles in our Diocese, out of 48 Councils.

We will be cooking hot dogs for the free throw competition in January, and will provide soft drinks. We need volunteers for both running the tournament and cooking.
